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America the Beautiful




Run Time: 60 minutes Episodes: Three

Features: original music

Issues: Immigration, racial prejudice Plot: A family from Peru moves to Los Angeles, but while the hard-working parents study to become legal immi-rants, their high school age children struggle to keep their family secret.

Features: collegelevel research

Issues: corporate greed, history of Old West, mining processes, environmental compliance.

Run Time: 60 minutes Episodes: Three

Features: multiple perspective s on single event

Issues: Terrorism, anger management Plot: Four students are falsely accused of damaging parked cars on campus, and harshly sentenced to jail time and community service. To retaliate, they plant a bomb on campus, eventually losing control of the damage done.

School:North Hollywood High School Media & Entertainment Academy, CA Research Elements: studies of headline news articles

Caught In a Web




Run Time: 60 minutes Episodes: Three

Issues: Internet predators

Plot: An unwary student responds in a chat room to a "friend" who turns out to be a criminal wanted for sexual assault. Finally working with the police, the student helps in a sting operation that captures the criminal.

Changes




Run Time: 60 minutes Episodes: Three Features: authentic details based on experience & police assistance

Issues: Date rape, teen social behavior, police procedures.

Plot: A young woman dresses scantily and flirts outrageously, but is shocked when she is raped by the fellow student she is dating. With counseling, she learns that although rape is a crime, she can also express wisdom.

School: Florence Crittenton Center High School, Los Angeles, CA Research Elements: interview with LAPD officer who visited class

Run Time: 60 minutes Episodes: Three

Features: original music

Issues: White-collar crime on the high seas; earthquake recovery in a major city Plot: An FBI agent tracks two credit-card thieves onto a cruise ship, uncovering their scam before passengers are fleeced. Meanwhile high school students whose parents are at sea deal with an earthquake at home in L.A.

Run Time: 82 minutes Episodes: Three

Features: professional actors added to cast


Issues: Family inheritance; California wine business; mad ambition.

Run Time: 60 minutes Episodes: Four Features: extraordinary underwater sound effects

Issues: Arctic environmental studies, US - Russian political relations, the U.S. SICEX nuclear submarine program.

Plot: Two voyages embark for the arctic - a US sub (carring scientists and a pompous movie star), and a Russian icebreaker. Scientists onboard must work together when the sub is trapped beneath the polar ice cap only the ice-breaker can free

School: University of Alaska Fairbanks Summer Fine Arts Camp, AK Research Elements: Director of Arctic Studies and SICEX scientists visited

Fountain Hills Mall




Run Time: 60 minutes Episodes: Three

Issues: Corporate greed, child kidnaping **Plot**: A mall owner contrives a kidnaping to increase publicity for his mall, and is horrified when his own daughter turns out to be the victim.

School: Fountain Valley School, CO Research Elements: Visited local mall, interviewed business owners

Run Time: 60 minutes Episodes: Three


Issues: Teen pregnancy, drug addiction.

Plot: At the Center, a home for teenage girls who are wards of the State, two girls give birth. One young mother's baby is crack-addicted, and she tries to swap her child with a healthy one. When she's discovered, rather than being punished, she is given help caring for her sick child, and learns a lesson about her own health and behavior.

School: Florence Crittenton Center High School, Los Angeles, CA

Research Elements: personal experience of young women living in a home for teenage mothers

Frozen Hearts: Alaskan Stories



Run Time: 60 minutes Episodes: Four

Issues: Alaskan statehood, Native Alaskan Tribal Corporations, ethics and morals

Plot: Through three generations, a bicultural family deals with the legacy of a Senator who secretly has children with two women of different races, one his wife and one his mistress.

School: University of Alaska Fairbanks Summer Fine Arts Camp, AK **Research Elements:** assistance from Yupik Native Alaskans

(The) Game



Run Time: 30 minutes Episodes: Three Features: written & performed by international students

Issues: Athletic competition, rivalry, friendship, honesty, drug in sports.

Plot: Quarterback Davide is no longer certain he's the best player on the team, especially when stiff competition from Boris erodes his confidence. His confidence is shaken further when three girls he likes all seem to favor Boris as well. To handle the problem Davide drugs Boris's drink, nearly causing him to be disqualified from the game. Will the truth come out in time?

Going Somewhere




Run Time: 60 minutes Episodes: Three

Run Time: 30 minutes Episodes: Three

Issues: Friendship, loyalty, privacy, relationships, journal writing.

Plot: When Stephanie notices Vanessa keeps a private journal, she plots to steal it – first to cover another of her own crimes, and second to break up Vanessa's relationship with George. Who do you

trust? Can you keep a secret? **School**: American School in Japan

K-RAP




Run Time: 60 minutes

Run Time: 36 minutes Episodes: Three


Features: Recorded by students both in Tokyo and Los Angeles

(The) Peak Mystery




Run Time: 60 minutes Episodes: Four

San Feliz




Run Time: 60 minutes Episodes: Three

But when arguments about interracial dating cause fear, parents discover they've been judging wrongly, friends discover they can trust one another after all, and authenticity proves to be stronger than secrets.

Tokyo Time Travelers




Run Time: 40 minutes Episodes: Three
